

Exchange Under TEFCA





ASTP defines overall policy and certain governance requirements

RCE provides oversight and governing approach for the Qualified Health Information Networks (QHINs)

QHINs connect directly to each other to facilitate nationwide interoperability

Each QHIN connects Participants, which connect Subparticipants

Participants and Subparticipants connect to each other through TEFCA Exchange

- Participants contract directly with a QHIN and may choose to also provide connectivity to others (Subparticipants), creating an expanded network of networks
- Participants and Subparticipants sign the same Terms of Participation and can generally participate in TEFCA Exchange in the same manner


TEFCA Governance Bodies



The Common Agreement and TEFCA Governance SOP establishes participatory governance for QHINs, Participants, and Subparticipants.

The Assistant Secretary for Technology Policy (ASTP) / Office of the National Coordinator for Health Information Technology (ONC) oversees the work of the RCE and these governing bodies.

The councils and caucuses provide feedback and support to address strategic and operational issues, and change management related to TEFCA, in coordination with ASTP and the RCE.

 Feedback period for Caucus members




Incorporate Caucus feedback (RCE and ASTP)

- Make any modifications needed
- Adjudicate any significant differences
- ASTP review



Share draft amendments in advance of votes by Caucus(es) for transparency

- Posted to RCE's governance webpage(s) for feedback no later than two weeks before Caucuses vote
- RCE takes feedback at all times via RCE inbox



- Approved version shared on website with explanation of next steps
- ASTP to determine timeline
